# **Funding opportunities?**

- 3 NOs (no new legislation, no new administration, no new funding)
- Policy framework for cooperation
- rather **informal governance structure** (with Steering Groups and Priority Area Coordinators) at an **operational level** and the EC (DG REGIO), a High-level Group, (TRIO) Presidency and National Coordinators at a **strategic level**.
- more creative/experimental ways of cooperating, e.g. by linking the Danube Transnational Programme with EUSDR PAs/PACs (to finance themselves), or providing a policy framework for funding opportunities.











# A policy framework to funding opportunities

- The preparation process of post-2020 programming offers a unique opportunity to all European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) and others such as IPA and NDICI (former ENI) to address territorial challenges in macro-regional strategies (MRS) more strategically.
- Previous experiences showed that a dialogue between authorities responsible for the programming process and key implementers of MRS are needed to make the best use of EU funding sources and to bring the strategic actions of MRS into these funding programmes.
















# Embedding in a multilevel strategic context

Practices in the 2014-2020 programming and implementation period have further shown that a better
coordination may require going beyond traditional administrative boundaries, and the will from
different levels of government to co-operate and co-ordinate strategic actions in order to achieve shared
goals and strengthen complementarities and synergies between different instruments.



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
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
