





PORT OF VUKOVAR – THROUGH THE HISTORY



The Port of Vukovar was established on 1st of January 1960. as an independent company

During the 1970s and 80s it was the biggest inland port in former Yugoslavia with 1,5 million tons of transshipment per year

Since April of 2002. it operates as an independent company in 100 % state ownership

The biggest river port in Croatia



PORT OF VUKOVAR




With the arrival of the global financial crisis in 2008.–2009. it marks a drastic decrease in traffic and income

Recovery of activities 2011.- 2012. and drop down in activities since 2013

In 2020. we marked transshipment at the level of 308.000 tons and the plan for 2021. are optimistic 350.000-400.000 tons

100% owned by the Republic of Croatia

Currently 62 employees

Max. transshipment in 2006 (915.000 t)

Located on 1335 rkm on the right bank of the Danube

Secured navigability 365 days a year

Luka -Vukovar d.o.o. is the largest authorized concessionare in the port area of the Port of Vukovar


Luka-Vukovar d.o.o. also develops agency services for both cargo ships and cruisers




PORT OF VUKOVAR - QUANTITIES OF TRANSHIPMENT PER YEAR











PORT OF VUKOVAR - CAPACITY




- 1 port mobile crane 63 t
- 2 port mobile cranes with 5/7 t capacity
- 1 port gantry crane 16/25 t
- 1 forklift 20 t
- 9 forklifts with a capacity of 2 to 5 t
- 2 loaders
- DHC locomotive 600 hp
- Priljevo tugboat with 480 hp
- C pallet load hook
- Grabs for bulk cargo with a capacity of 5 m³ to 13 m³
- Container transshipment devices, etc...



PORT OF VUKOVAR


- The total surface of the port area is 18.5 ha
- The length of the operational shore is 450 m
- 4 berths fully equipped with all infrastructure
- Closed covered warehouse of 2.500 m²
- Open storage for about 15.000 to 20.000 tons







PORT OF VUKOVAR – INVESTMENT PLANS IN THE MIDDLE-TERM PERIOD



- Reconstruction and revitalization and putting into operation a closed warehouse in the floor warehouse for cereals as well as arranging office building for the needs of the port
- Investment in electric forklifts and cars as part of the green and transition economy project
- Total investments exceed
 20.000.000 €

- The plan is to implement several projects through EU funds, of which one is"smart port,, complete revitalization of the superstructure through investment in energy efficiency, solar panels on a closed warehouse with the potential for electricity production, energy from the wind, etc...
- ICT project of information and communication technology, digitalization of port
- New Port Infrastructure on 2.2 h
 (st.1)





LONG TERM INVESTMENT PLAN

- A feasibility study for the relocation of Luka– Vukovar d.o.o. has been made
- The position of noncore property in the former complex of the Borovo is chosen



- The investment area is 18.5 ha
- All communal infrastructure available
- Good traffic connection
 - Electrified railway

STRENGHT

- Existing economic purpose
- Close to the existing and future business zone
 - Utility fit-out
- Proximity to the existing port area

OPPORTUNITIES

- Possibility of achieving synergy effects with existing economic facilities
- Possibility of direct connection to the railway and road network
- Total investments in 2
 phases reaches 471 million
 HRK or 62 million € 85% of
 it is co-financed by EU
 funds
- Transshipment capacity over 2.5 million tons
 - 200 new employees
